

Auto maintenance checklist

Proper maintenance helps your vehicle operate safely and efficiently. Use this checklist to stay on top of regular maintenance and keep your vehicle running.*

Monthly												
Check automatic transmission fluid												
Check brake fluid level												
Check coolant/antifreeze level												
Check engine oil level												
Inspect interior and exterior lights												
Check power steering fluid												
Check tire pressure and condition												
Check windshield washer fluid												

Every 6 months												
Check brakes and wheel bearings <i>Every 6 months or 6,000 miles</i>												
Check exhaust system												
Inspect battery cables												
Inspect belts												
Inspect hoses for cracks												
Inspect steering and suspension <i>Every 6 months or 6,000 miles</i>												
Inspect wiper blades												
Rotate tires and check alignment <i>Every 6 months or 6,000 miles</i>												

Annually												
Check air conditioning system												
Change cabin air filter												
Test vehicle battery												

Periodically												
Change engine oil and filter <i>Every 5,000 to 7,500 miles</i>												
Change engine air filter <i>Every 15,000 to 30,000 miles</i>												
Flush and replace coolant <i>Every 2 to 5 years</i>												
Inspect spark plugs and spark plug wires <i>Consult vehicle owner's manual</i>
